Re: Asphalt Overlay / Watermain Improvements

Dear Residents:

The Village of Caseyville has awarded a contract to construct a 2" asphalt overlay over Hollywood Heights Road from Highway 157 to Oliver Street. The project will also consist of replacing the older watermain on the south side of the road. The overlay, we hope to be starting within the next month or two and completed in this year's construction period. The new waterline is already in the process and is being done by the Caseyville Water Department.

Expect some delays in traffic and lane closures at times. We anticipate keeping at least one lane of traffic open during construction. During construction we will keep the jobsite as clean as possible. Front yards and driveways will be disturbed with this construction. The areas that will be disturbed will be closer to the street. Be assured the contractor and the water department will replace disturbed areas as to the condition it was originally or better. After the contractor is done you may see some settling of the ground at times in the new watermain placement area. We will keep a close eye on this and add fill dirt as needed going forward. These areas will be reseeded and strawed as necessary.
