Public Comment Portion:

Mayor Scott opened the floor to the public to comment on the annual appropriation ordinance title: Ordinance 2019-11 An Ordinance making Annual Appropriation for the Fiscal Year of June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2019

Resident Matt Modrovsky commented on the deficit listed in the budget for Fiscal Year of June 1, 2019 through May 31, 2019.

Attorney Kaufhold explained that the hearing is to allow for public comments and that the Board need not answer any questions made during the comment period.
