 - Levee discussion everyone wants to point the Village for repairs, however, why are property owners not maintaining, the Village taxpayers should not be responsible for all the repairs. Village can make temporary repairs and then have property owners give us ownership rights, then the Village would have to respond with a Levee Tax, which I as a taxpayer do not want to pay. The land could possibly be acquired but it would be at Market Value and how would that be funded thru the Village. Then a special service district would need to be set-up which would cause an increase in property tax and/or acquire a levee tax to maintain. Currently working on a mechanism that all parties are responsible to maintain/repair their portion of the levee/property. Would have to hire a Civil Engineer to review water shed, then lobby for funding with a project proposal; at which time there is no \$ amount dedicated to this project and there is no timeline. Have been working with the Southwestern Flood District counsel regarding the Hardin Ditch. In 2018 was a grant given, and if so, where did those monies go; not sure, will have to do some investigating. Wasn't there a plan to do some concrete work on the Canteen, where is that plan; again, will have to do some investigating. The issue is trash, trees, other items are flowing down these creeks starting east of 159 and coming into Caseyville, how can that be prevented? Be advised that if FEMA comes into the Village for inspections, you must abide by their flood plan regulations, Village has no say on them. Maybe plan a Town Hall meeting for the Village flood victims to give them some updates. Still waiting to hear from FEMA as to how they are going to assist the Caseyville residents, should be in a few weeks.
