**Police:**

- Add to Agenda – the State Law is requiring all police departments to have Body Cams. State money is available; however, we must pay up front & then be reimbursed by the State (thru Grants). Have been getting some bids, with funding available, Axon Enterprise has the best offer. \$122,000 for everything with a 5-year contract, every 2 ½ years they replace equipment at no cost and repair equipment as needed, we can set-up yearly payments of a little over \$24,000 every year which is doable thru the Budget. This is a cloud base storage system. Currently the Police force has car cameras, but not body cameras as this will become Mandatory by next year. There is a possibility more Grant money will be available later to cover additional storage and other costs.
- Police Station renderings were revealed showing how it will be attached to Village Hall. This is being done thru a \$4 million grant with further funding. Please note “No House Property Taxes Will be Raised for this Facility”! Plans are to have Groundbreaking on 3/31/2023, with Local Reps and State Reps in attendance, further details will be forthcoming. The current Police Station is in really bad shape and over 100 years old.
