### COMMITTEE REPORT:

#### Administrative/Communications/Closed Minute Review:

- Republic Trash Services – how can we get the size regulation changed or a better understanding with Republic how they interpret large items. This will definitely be looked into during renegotiations.

#### Ordinance:

- Discuss the Hazmat situation that occurred last week. There needs to be an Ordinance regarding what can be hauled into the Village permit and what permits are needed/required and by whom. Definitely do not want hazmat materials stored within the Village. There should be a plate on any container that is hauling hazardous materials stating what is in the tanks. Drivers should have all the necessary permits needed for hauling and storage. This is not an everyday occurrence for the Village, but need to provide what needs to be done and who should be informed; IDOT, Emergency Management, St. Clair County, etc. Impose fines. What about the Trains that sit on the tracks for hours, how should they be handled with hazmat materials. Candi Eaves, you may want to contact Larry Lockhart located at Twin Lake Trucking for possible assistance with the Ordinance, as he works with hazmat materials daily. There are possibly other Agencies that need to be involved as well; EPA, OSHA, truck companies who are hauling, etc.
