- Senator Harris and Trina have been meeting with IDOT regarding the Guard Rail Issue on 157 to protect the homes in the new subdivision. Sgt. Allison has provided pictures of the homes involved and along the bluff area across the street, to show the need for a Guard Rail. Looking to change the speed limit from Bunkum to Bridge Inn on 157. During the following months, the following car count was made:

February – 270,423

March - 405,256

April – 458,456

For a total of 1,134,135 Vehicles going through Town. Will follow up with Senator Harris to see where we are in the process. We are still waiting for the Speed Limit report that was captured with the Radar machine.

**Public Works/Building:**

- Levee Project with other Municipalities, State and Federal hoping to get the Board Support for the Mayor, Doug Stewart, Phil Little and Brian Rader to continue their efforts on this project, as they are wanting the Village of Caseyville to take the lead with this Project. Doug is working on making the Village study a presentation to FEMA, the Army Corp of Engineers within the next 45 days. The last 60 days of work have begun in the Spring Lake Project (detention basin) and really want to continue our efforts with this project as well and personnel will be focusing their time on this more. Yes, we must do something to try and alleviate this issue in the years to come. Is there a possibility to have a presentation for the Public to see where we are in the process, County has been giving the public opportunities to observe these presentations, I could provide a 2-page summary if that would be of assistance. The Board definitely supports whatever efforts/resources you need to make this Levee Project happen and doable.
